Dippy's coming to Rochdale

The Natural History Museum's famous Diplodocus dinosaur has left the museum for the first time to go on a UK tour and Rochdale is one of his stops.

The dino superstar has already visited Dorset, Birmingham, Belfast, Glasgow and Newcastle and Rochdale will be his only stop in the North West.

The tour, which has already attracted 1.4m visitors, will reach Rochdale in February 2020 and schools can book their tickets now.

Our natural history adventure includes the opportunity for pupils to meet Dippy at Number One Riverside to begin their scientific enquiry before heading to Touchstones Rochdale to complete their learning in the specially designed natural history exhibition.
