GOOD CHILD REPORT

In August The Children's Society published their annual good child report which explores *the latest trends in children's well-being... their family, financial circumstance, multiple disadvantage and what children and young people think about the future* (link above).

FEARLESS.ORG

Fearless is a site where young people can access non-judgmental information and advice about crime and criminality. While this is a useful resource to support young people, it also provides support for professionals including a varied resource library (link below).



SUICIDE & SELF HARM SUPPORT APPS

distrACT is a free app for people who self-harm. Made with young people in mind, it gives people access to relevant, reassuring and reliable information. The app recently won the British Medical Association's 'Patient Information Award' in the wellbeing category.

NATIONAL REFERRAL MECHANISM (NRM)

The National Referral Mechanism (NRM) is a framework for identifying and referring potential victims of modern slavery and ensuring they receive the appropriate support. We have created a guidance document which explains how to complete the referral form before it is considered by the relevant Single Competent Authority (SCA) within the Home Office (link at top of page). SCREENING TOOLS

The Pan Cheshire Exploitation Screening Tool is designed to support frontline professionals in helping to identify and raise concerns regarding the exploitation of children. Your Local Safeguarding Board/Partnership Website has all the information you need to complete one. Young Addaction are also able to help support you with any queries you may have.

Young Addaction can support you one on one to complete them, or come out to a team meeting to provide advice and guidance on completing the tool
