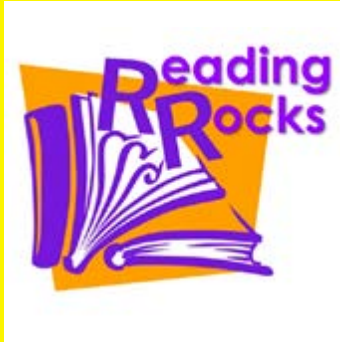


Mama G
