



Title: Teaching and Learning about Islam Course

The aim of this two-hour Islam course is to support primary school teachers develop their subject knowledge and increase their confidence in teaching Islam to pupils. Teachers will also be supported with the correct pronunciation of key Islamic terminology.

The session will be led by Imran Kotwal. He is the founder of **IslamREsources.co.uk** and **Muslim Learner Services**, an organisation set up over five years ago to promote a better understanding of Islam and British Muslims in schools.

Imran will deliver an engaging and practical training session. Teachers will be introduced to the origins of the five pillars of Islam through the famous tradition of Angel Gabriel (Jibreel). This will be followed by an exploration of Islamic artefacts, how they are used by Muslims today and how they link to the five pillars of Islam. The session then moves on to studying each of the five pillars in-depth using presentation, worksheets, activities, video, and stories.

There will be an opportunity to ask questions throughout the session and there will also be a Q&A session at the end of the course.

All delegates will receive a training booklet packed with Islam teaching and learning resources and a full copy of the training presentation.
