We are writing to introduce you to a new educational resource available for free to all schools, supported through the Liverpool City Region's Community Environment Fund.

[www.cleanaircrew.co.uk](http://www.cleanaircrew.co.uk) is an interactive resource to help teach your pupils about air quality issues affecting your community. All city region schools are being offered free access to the subscription only sections of the website – including fun, interactive resources and games and a plethora of topic based curriculum resources supporting the site, to engage your school community in this important environmental issue. The website and all resources have been designed and developed by teachers.

Furthermore, once subscribed, your parents will have the opportunity to sign up for home learning access too. Air quality has been highlighted as one of the city region's key environmental and health policies and it is our hope that the resource provides an accessible platform for engagement for all.

- The site will be fully completed and launched in June after the half term break, however we are inviting schools and teachers to register now. Once fully launched we will be in contact about how your parents can also access the resource for home learning activities.
- Please sign up @ [www.cleanaircrew.co.uk](http://www.cleanaircrew.co.uk). Your school can have multiple accounts so please share this information with all your teaching colleagues. This is important so we can report how the resource is being used across the key stages and continue funding it.
- Explore the wealth of bespoke lessons plans and homework activities to be used across the website, all complementing and supporting current National Curriculum aims and objectives.
- Please sign up no later than **30<sup>th</sup> June 2021** to enable us to report usage to the combined authority. Based on the current funding, if you register by then, your school's subscription will last until April 2022. We are hopeful that we will be successful in continuing funding free access to the resource beyond that so reporting on engagement is crucial.

As we return from lockdown, we do not want to bring back poor air quality with us - now is the perfect time to get involved.
