KEY INFORMATION FOR THE COURSES

Level 1

What's the course about?

This is an ideal introductory course for anyone thinking about a career in Education settings and is excellent preparation for the Level 2 course.

When will it be?

This course will run on Thursdays starting in January 2022 and finishing in July. The time of the course will be 9:30am to 2:30pm at Kingsway learning Centre.

What qualifications do I need?

To be eligible for a place, learners should be working at Entry 3 Literacy in order to access the written materials, create a portfolio and complete assessments.

What is the cost?

The course will cost £60 per term plus £30 qualification/registration fee. Fee remission is available for those in receipt of benefits.

Level 2

What's the course about?

This is a full year course for learners who would like to work in an education setting. Successful learners will achieve the CACHE L2 Certificate in Supporting Teaching and Learning in Schools.

When will it be?

The course runs either on a Tuesday or Wednesday 9:30-2:30 starting in September 2021 and you will complete in July 2022.

What qualifications do I need?

To be eligible for a place, learners should have a Level 1 maths and English qualification and consider working towards a Level 2 qualification.

What is the cost?

The course will cost £60 per term over three terms. Additionally, there is an Awarding body registration fee or £30 and a DBS certification cost of £44. Fee remission is available for those in receipt of benefits
