## WellComm Training

An overview of the Early Years WellComm Screening Toolkit, including why early identification and intervention is important, how to complete screenings and what to do next. This training video will be useful for practitioners who are new to the toolkit and also as a refresher.

Walkthrough videos, with useful hints and tips are also able for each section of the WellComm screening.

## TALK EAL (An Introduction to English as an Additional Language)

An introduction to what it means to be bilingual, the typical pattern of learning English as an Additional Language, and ways for practitioners to support this.

TALK Support

TALK Transitions

A look at the range of transitions children experience and how they can impact children. This session also looks at a range of strategies to support transitions, including visual supports.
