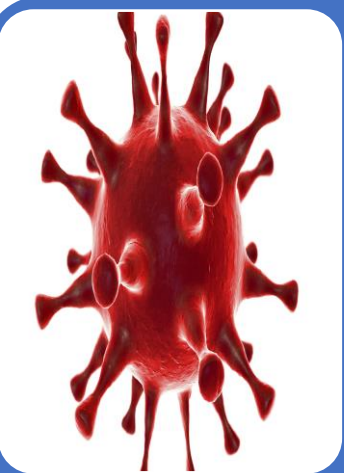


- Site visits and support across the local areas

Outbreak and single infections management

- All outbreaks of infection (2 or more cases) are reported to the IPCT . This includes all communicable infections i.e., Covid, D&V, Influenza.
- Schools can link in with the UKHSA Cheshire & Merseyside Health Protection Team for advice and guidance
